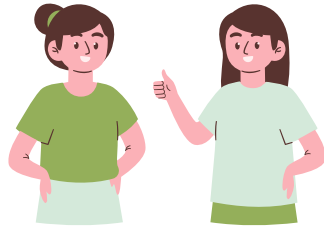


UNIT 8 CHORES

- D) Emma will do the laundry alone on Sunday.

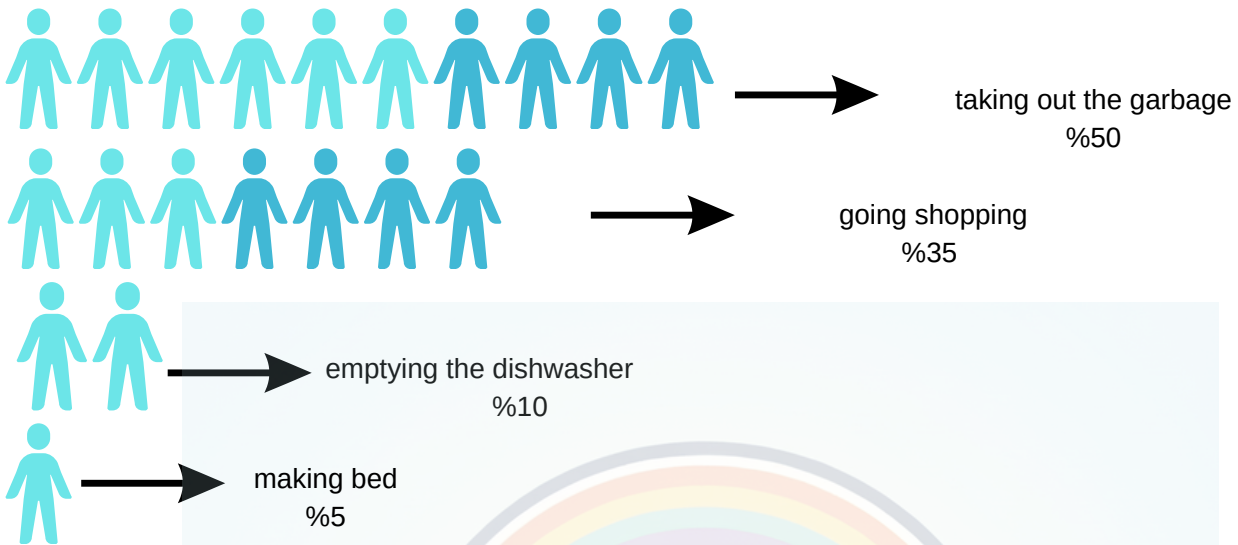
