**Will (for predictions)**

Certainty: "Will" is used when we are fairly sure or confident about what will happen in the future.  
Example: The sun will rise tomorrow. (This is something we are almost certain about.)

**May (for predictions):**

Possibility: "May" is used when the event is uncertain or less likely to happen. It suggests a chance or possibility, but not certainty.

Example: We may get a snowstorm this week. (It's possible, but we're not sure.)

**Key difference:**

Use "will" when you're confident the event will happen. ( olacağı ihtimaline çok güveniyorsan , emin gibiyse)

Use "may" when the event is uncertain or just a possibility. ( olacağı kesin olmayan, sadece bir olasılık ise)

### Will (for predictions)

Certainty: "Will" is used when we are fairly sure or confident about what will happen in the future.

Example: The sun will rise tomorrow. (This is something we are almost certain about.)

### May(for predictions):

Possibility: "May" is used when the event is uncertain or less likely to happen. It suggests a chance or possibility, but not certainty.

Example: We may get a snowstorm this week. (It's possible, but we're not sure.)

### Key difference:
